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Safety Induction, Rules & Code of Conducts

Welcome to Putty Valley Adventures!

In order for every guest to have a safe, relaxing, and enjoyable time we need to ensure that all guests are aware of and abide by the terms & conditions at all times while in the venue.

Please note that we take our duty of care responsibilities very seriously. Venue management reserve the right to **expel and/or suspend any person** from the venue should any action or behaviour be considered as a serious risk or consequence to the safety, enjoyment, and wellbeing of others or that of the venue and its surroundings.

Subject:	Requirement:
Emergency (injury, missing person, fire, disturbance)	See PVA Management immediately. First aid support including an AED is available at the site office.
Evacuation of venue	Proceed directly to the primary or secondary assembly area as directed by staff and REMAIN THERE until accounted for.
Speed limit on entry/exit track to the venue	15km/h – registered vehicles & riders entering or leaving ONLY . Violators will be expelled from the venue.
Speed limit in “common areas” (camping areas, day visit car park, site office and public amenities areas)	Walking pace – all vehicles
Operating hours	Please respect other people in the campground
Novice/Junior riding area	No access for Intermediate or Advanced riders. Violators will be expelled from the venue.
Flat track, motocross track, Enduro tracks and SxS tracks	No access for Novice riders. Violators will be suspended from riding. Carry drinking water & tell someone where you are going before departing. It is strongly recommended that you bring a two-way radio with you.
Direction of travel – all riding/driving areas	Direction as marked ONLY . Violators will be expelled from the venue
Rider/driver behaviour	Riders/drivers who endanger others through their actions, or engage in aggressive riding/driving behaviour towards others may be expelled from the venue
AS-approved Helmets and riding boots	To be worn AT ALL TIMES whilst riding
Protective equipment	We strongly encourage wearing goggles, gloves, long sleeve shirts and long pants.
Camp sites	Remain clean at all times. No rubbish <i>especially</i> glass to be left onsite
Camp site fires	Tents and combustible items to be kept clear. Fires to remain controlled, within fire rings, and extinguished before departure. No fires permitted during designated regional fire ban periods.
Noise/music curfew	10pm-7.30am – respect other patrons
Alcohol consumption and general behaviour	Intoxicated or otherwise bad behaviour that upsets other guests will not be tolerated. No riding whilst intoxicated. Violators will be expelled from the venue.
Site Office	Open between 7am and 6pm
Ablutions facility	Water is classed as non-potable. Do not drink it.
Fauna hazards and care for the environment	Be aware of the bush environment – snakes are present in the venue. Riders to remain within marked areas only.

PVA Code of Conducts:

At PVA, we believe in providing a safe and enjoyable environment for all our guests. We don't have too many rules, but the few we do have are strictly enforced. No glass containers are permitted in the fire pit due to risk of glass fragments, and no burnouts are allowed in the campground. Additionally, we caution all participants to wear a helmet at all times when riding motorcycles or ATVs. We thank you for your cooperation and understanding so that everyone can have a pleasant and unforgettable experience!
